The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Appellant's Case:

The appellant gave evidence. He outlined his employment at the respondent company. He commenced employment in 2001 and in September 2004 there was a transfer of undertakings when the public house was sold. The appellant continued in his employment for a further twelve months. When he returned his keys on the 13th October 2005, he was told his job was gone.

Determination:

The Tribunal are satisfied that the respondent had been properly served notice of this appeal. Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal determines that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, succeeds and awards the appellant his statutory redundancy payment based on the following information:
